WHEN: Submit your entry by lunchtime on **Wednesday, April 7** – put it in the *What a Life!* box in the main office

WHO: All TEMS students! For each grade, the homeroom with the highest participation will win a **PIZZA PARTY** – to be scheduled for lunchtime with your homeroom teacher at a later date.

RULES: Only original entries will be accepted. Each entry must be completed by one student only - this is an individual challenge. Have fun!
